



SCHOLAR UNIFORM POLICY

Our uniform policy is designed to minimize distractions, create uniformity and increase school pride. Scholars are expected to wear their complete school uniforms to school every day, including field lessons. Scholars are expected to wear the following:

UNIFORM POLICY	
Shirts	Purple polo shirt <u>with school logo</u> . Available for purchase in the office for \$8.00 each. Plain short or long sleeve undershirts are allowed. <i>Fridays Only: College t-shirts or school t-shirts may be worn. Jerseys are not allowed.</i>
Sweatshirts or Cardigans	Black <u>school logo</u> sweatshirt and <u>school logo</u> cardigans. Sweatshirts are available in the office for \$12.00 each. The Clarksdale Collegiate polo shirt must be seen when a sweatshirt or cardigan is worn. <i>Shirts, sweaters and fleeces without the Clarksdale Collegiate logo are not allowed inside the classroom.</i> <i>Fridays Only: College sweaters or sweatshirts may be worn.</i>
Pants	Khaki pants. Khaki shorts. Khaki skirts, skorts or jumpers at or below the knee. <i>Fridays Only: Blue jean pants, shorts, skirts, or skorts may be worn.</i>
Shoes	<u>Sneakers are required</u> as scholars have recess daily. Shoes must be closed toed, flat, rubber-soled shoes. Snow or Rain boots can be worn to and from school, with a change of shoes brought in a backpack. Lightup shoes, shoes with wheels, any type of boots or otherwise distracting shoes are not allowed.
Belts	Belts must be wore if bottoms have belt loops.
Jewelry	Scholars are not allowed to wear disruptive jewelry. (e.g. jewelry that distracts from learning) Earrings must be dime sized or smaller. Scholars may not wear bracelets, rings, as they can prevent children from writing properly. Talking or beeping watches are disruptive and are not allowed. Artificial nails are not allowed.
Headwear	Scholars are not allowed to wear hats or headwear unless worn for religious purpose.
